Originally asked to look at the impact of changing existing shift patterns and what effect this may have on the existing maintenance regime, the assignment changed focus from being purely a maintenance audit into a more wide ranging study of existing maintenance effectiveness.

The assignment was carried out at the Client's long-established Oxfordshire site, and looked at all aspects of the licensed site's maintenance regime and the interactions between operations and maintenance personnel. A follow up visit to site is planned within the next two months to present the results of the study and to highlight recommendations and opportunities for improvement.
